Cell Phone Policy

All students who attend Continuation and Mission Community Day School will have to put their cell phones into a safe box upon entering the class. The teacher or aide will collect the phones at the beginning of the period. All phones will be well protected and returned to each student at the end of the day. Not all students are here on punishment, and the taking of the cell phones is not done in the vein of punishment. Rather, we take the phones to get students to focus as much as possible while here. Additionally, student safety is a high priority for us and having the phones also reduces potential problems that can arise from texting and social media. Students claiming to not have a phone on them will be trusted. But if a phone is observed on the student during the course of the school day the student will be asked to surrender the phone immediately. If a student refuses to give the phone up a parent will be called and further disciplinary action will be taken by the administrative staff.

- 1st Offense: The phone will be taken away, awarning will be issued, phone returned at the end of the day.
- 2nd Offense: The phone will be taken away and a mandatory detention will be assigned, a parent must come and pick the phone up.
- 3rd Offense: Parent, teacher, student and administrator meeting about current placement. Students not allowed back to school until the meeting takes place. Solution made or changes made to adhere to the school rules without incident.

Those students who cannot comply with the rules of the Kings Lake Education center will face further disciplinary action which could lead to expulsion from the school and the district. All students who fall under the jurisdiction of these rules will be expected to sign this phone contract as acknowledgment and acceptance of the school rules.
